Lower Leas Coastal Park

Lower Sandgate Road Folkestone CT20 2JP

Tuesday 2nd August

11am-3pm

Free

The park is split into three recreational zones, starting at The Leas Lift, the formal zone comprises pine avenues, gardens and flowers. The fun zone is home to the largest free adventure play area in the south east and the ever popular amphitheatre. The wild zone is a haven for quiet recreation, where sensitive habitat management allows wildlife to thrive.

Walmer Paddling Pool

The Strand, Walmer, Deal, CT14 7HX

This is a lovely shallow pool surrounded by secure fencing and set on Walmer Green, just a few feet from the beach. The pool has qualified lifeguards, a kiosk serving hot/cold snacks, changing rooms and toilets. It really is a lovely, relaxing simple day with SNAAP staff on hand to help. Adjacent is crazy golf, play area with large children's games and a bouncy castle (additional costs).

A great family day out at one of the best small zoo's in the country, this animal and child friendly family environment has interactive displays, amazing play areas, an interactive maze, a state-of-the-art soft play complex, Thomas the Tank engine train ride and their new attraction, Hello Kitty Secret Garden - which includes a Hello Kitty car ride, tea cup ride and a "reach for the sky" hopper ride.

Sno-Rings and Accessible Toboggan

Children with physical disabilities sit or lay in an enclosed toboggan which is led gently down the slope. There are no hoists so you will need to be able to transfer your child. All other children will use the sno-rings. Please note there is disabled changing facilities with hoist.

This scheme is for young people with less complex needs who **do not** require 1:1 support.

Regular activities include outdoor play, soft play room, games, crafts, cooking, water play and going to the beach or park. Each day will also have a theme but your child can choose not to take part in this.

KCC are part funding this and their criteria includes children who have an EHCP (or Statement of SEN) and are in a special school/or in a unit attached to a mainstream school.

SNAAP is then part funding children who do not meet the above criteria. This only requires your child to be in receipt of DLA.

A **care plan must be** completed and **sent with your booking form** in order to assess your child's needs (unless already done) and your booking is not accepted until payment is made (non-refundable).

Please note: **Places are limited** and you may not receive every date you request.
