This scheme is for young people with less complex needs who **do not** require 1:1 support. There will be games, crafts, outdoor play, soft play room. Each day will also have a theme but your child can choose not to take part in this.

KCC Social Services are part funding this club and their criteria includes children who have an EHCP (or Statement of SEN) and are in a special school/or in a unit attached to a mainstream school. However, SNAAP is also funding some of the places, which only requires your child to be in receipt of DLA. Priority will be given to children that live in the Canterbury District. A care plan must be completed in order to assess your child’s needs (unless already done).
