

## **SNAAP Volunteer Role Description**

**Post Title:** Volunteer Play Support Worker

**Responsible To:** Play Support Leader

**Overall Purpose:**

- To help support the delivery of SNAAP services, in providing accessible play and leisure activities for disabled children and young people aged 8-25 years old.
- To gain valuable experience of working with disabled children and young people and learn to encourage them whilst helping them have an equal opportunity to take part in all aspects of SNAAP.

Due to the regular contact with children and young people, this post is subject to an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.

**Main Duties**

- Being part of the SNAAP team that provides a high quality, safe, fun and friendly play and leisure service for children and young people aged 0-25
- To support the Play Support Lead and other staff in all aspects of care and supervision of children and young people who attend SNAAP – encouraging and supporting children to fully realise their abilities and providing a safe and happy play environment.
- Be a team member, supporting other volunteers and workers on the scheme.
- Help the team keep venues and sites clean, tidy and secure.
- Attend training sessions and meetings that are needed to carry out the role.
- Report any concern about a child's welfare or safety in accordance with SNAAP's Child Protection Policy and Procedure.
- To conduct yourself and represent the Charity in a manner which reflects all the values and principles of SNAAP.

- Be highly motivated with an outgoing and fun loving personality
- A desire to work with children and young people and to enjoy that work
- Be proactive, creative and possess skills that are successful in delivering positive outcomes for children and young people
- Must be reliable and punctual
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Commitment to the aims and work of SNAAP, including an understanding of and ability to adhere to SNAAP's policies and procedures
